*A full day of scientific diving at our monitoring sites along the coast of the island that are only accessible by boat.*

9:30 AM - Briefing & Fish ID Training

10:30 AM - Survey Dive #2

12:30 PM - Survey Dive #3

1:30 PM - Debrief and data entry

2:30 PM - Boat returns to Avalon

## CATALINA COMMUNITY CLEANUP

*Hosting a Catalina Community Cleanup to leave a lasting impact on the island we call home.*

Three nights at Hermit Gulch Campground on Catalina Island.

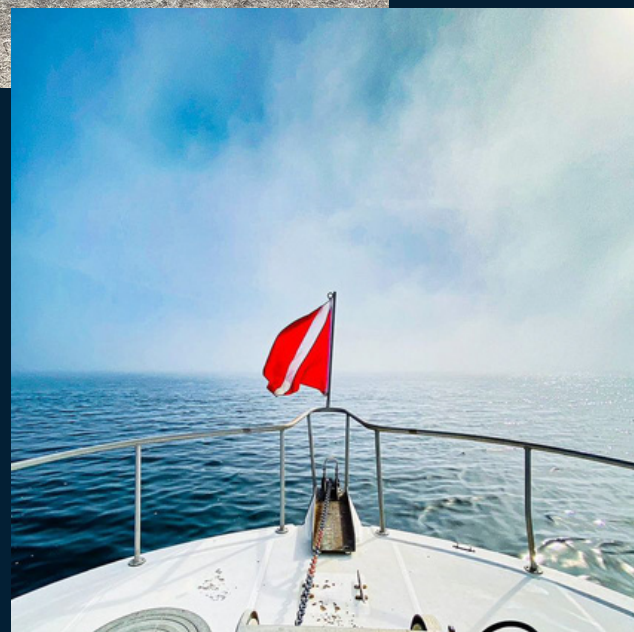
Full Campsite Setup: Six person tent, cot bed with padded cushion, blanket and pillow.
